Overarching Goal:

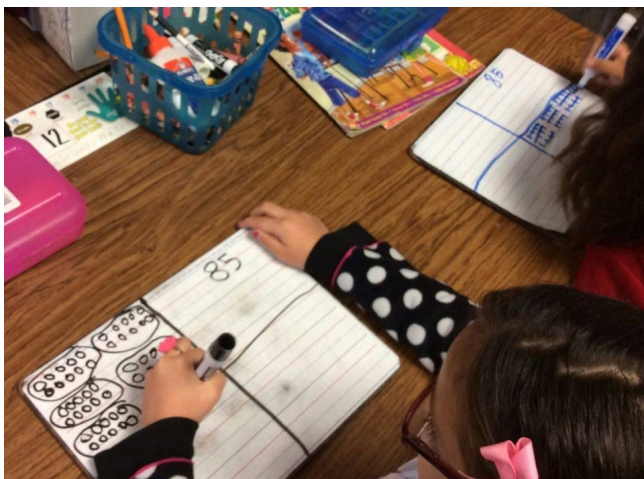
To foster students' development as problem solvers who bring skill and confidence to mathematics situations.

Guiding Principle

Children bring intuitive knowledge of mathematics to problem solving situations (count objects, share "fairly", manipulate quantities, etc.).

Teaching Approach:

Elicit children's mathematical thinking and use it as the basis for instructional decisions. Connect new mathematical ideas to prior knowledge to promote learning math with conceptual understanding.
